Stillpoint Farm is the result of Page's vision to create a world-class training facility where riders could work together in a supportive environment. "The goal for Stillpoint Farm has always been to offer

our clients the best amenities possible, and with the addition of MC Ecotrack we are certainly providing a training surface on par with the best that Europe has to offer,” said Page.

Robert Dover, Oded Shimoni, Lisa Wilcox, and, of course, Page herself call Stillpoint Farm home. “The idea to have several top trainers under one roof blossomed at the farm in 2006. Because of this, riders of all levels are encouraged to strive for personal excellence as they are surrounded by the best there is to offer, from Olympic-level dressage to top notch footing,” Page said.

All of Stillpoint’s trainers appreciate the MC Ecotrack footing, and Glynnie Walford, the former UK managing director for Martin Collins who is now in charge of the U.S. operation, is thrilled that their product is being embraced. “MC Ecotrack produces controlled energy-return, which relates to the surface’s cushioning effect and the way it reduces concussion,” she said. “Tuny has told us that one of the many reasons she loves MC Ecotrack is that her last five horses in the arena during the day get the same top footing that the first five experienced at the beginning of the day.”

Page added, “We have also gone from spending three hours daily to prepare our arena to about 30 minutes. There is absolutely no dust so our arena, mirrors, kick-boards and viewing deck stay clean with minimal care.”

Page is also delighted that Martin Collins Equine Surfaces made an excellent job of working with the needs of Stillpoint Farm. “I can trust Martin Collins to know and completely understand their product and how it will react in any circumstances,” she said.

Stillpoint Farm, located at 4394 South Shore Boulevard in Wellington, is situated on 10 acres and features a 34-stall main stable divided into four private wings. The north and south wings contain their own wash racks, tack rooms, laundry rooms, offices, kitchens and full bathrooms. Connected to the indoor is a fully equipped "casino" with full kitchen, several bathrooms, big screen TV and complete Pilates studio. The outdoor ring at the farm is regulation size and is beautifully presented with hedging, letters, and shade trees. “We have the use of an irrigated 10 acre "stick and ball" next door for field

work, jumping and conditioning,” Page said. “During season we also offer stabling in lovely 12x12 stalls in our portable tent stabling. The farm has ample turnout space.”
